


WE HAVE TO DO THIS RIGHT, OR NOT AT ALL.








"ACADEMIC INDIGENOUS/NON-INDIGENOUS RESEARCH PARTNERSHIPS CAN PERPETUATE THIS. THERE CAN BE ASSUMPTIONS IN WESTERN SCHOLARSHIP THAT YOUR KNOWLEDGE FRAMEWORKS ARE BETTER AND CAN ONLY HELP INDIGENOUS SCHOLARSHIP, REPLICATING ASSUMPTIONS OF INFERIORITY."

"THERE IS ALSO A TENDENCY TO ASSUME THAT ALL INDIGENOUS RESEARCH FRAMEWORKS ARE THE SAME, BUT INDIGENOUS PEOPLE ARE DIVERSE AND GLOBAL. SO THERE IS NO ONE SIZE FITS ALL SOLUTION WHEN IT COMES TO INDIGENOUS/NON-INDIGENOUS PARTNERSHIPS OTHER THAN A STARTING POINT THAT RECOGNISES THE IMPACTS OF COLONISATION."



"JUST AS INDIGENOUS PEOPLES ARE NOT A HOMOGENOUS GLOBAL GROUP, INDIGENOUS RESEARCH METHODOLOGIES ARE NOT HOMOGENOUS; THEY ARE GROUNDED IN OUR VARIOUS AND SPECIFIC WORLD VIEWS."


WE NEED TO GET SOME PAPERS OUT SOON, HAVE YOU DONE ENOUGH ANALYSIS TO START ON A DRAFT?

WE'RE NOT REALLY "WORKING IN AOTEAROA NEW ZEALAND", IT'S A MUTUAL PARTNERSHIP WITH CLEAR ROLES. MAIA'S LEADERSHIP IS KEY AND SO IS UNDERSTANDING OUR POSITION AND ACCOUNTABILITIES.

WE CAN TELL YOU ABOUT WHAT WE LEARNT, BUT WHAT WORKED FOR US MAY NOT WORK FOR YOU.

"HOWEVER, THIS IS OUR ADVICE: WE HAD TO LEARN TO BUILD A TEAM RELATIONSHIP BASED ON MUTUAL RESPECT. EVEN THOUGH WE WERE ON OTHER SIDES OF THE WORLD, MAIA IS OUR PARTNER AND WE NEEDED TO BE GUIDED BY HER AND LISTEN."



"AND OUR TEAM RELATIONSHIP DIDN'T EMERGE INSTANTLY... WE HAD TO ASK OURSELVES SOME DIFFICULT QUESTIONS, STEP OUTSIDE OUR COMFORT ZONES AND WORK HARD TO DEVELOP TRUST."

"WE HAD TO THINK ABOUT WHAT WE WERE DOING, AND WHY. WE COULDN'T JUST TAKE OUR KNOWLEDGE AND WAYS WE WERE USED TO WORKING FOR GRANTED - WE HAD TO STEP BACK, LEARN AND VALUE MULTIPLE CONTRIBUTIONS."



"I TOOK A RISK WORKING WITH PEOPLE I DIDN'T KNOW THAT WELL AND WHO DIDN'T KNOW MUCH ABOUT HOW WE WORK. BUT I TRUSTED THEM AND THEY LISTENED - AND OUR PROJECT TURNED INTO SOMETHING USEFUL AND SPECIAL."
